Modified GRF(1-29), also called CJC-1295 without DAC, is a stabilized GHRH analog with improved potency. It produces a short, pulse-like GH release that mirrors the body's natural pattern.

Protocol & Dosage

Recommended dosage: 100 200 mcg per injection, 2 3x daily

Biological half-life: 30 minutes

Administration: Subcutaneous injection (typical)
