Motilin is a 22-amino-acid GI peptide that regulates migrating motor complexes during fasting. Motilin agonists are investigated for gastroparesis and post-surgical gut recovery.

Protocol & Dosage

Recommended dosage: Motilin agonists (e.g., camicinal) ~0.1-0.2 mg/kg oral in trials

Biological half-life: 5 minutes

Administration: Subcutaneous injection (typical)
